

Neutral technical support

The organizers will provide neutral technical assistance for road races. All teams are allowed escorted by team car.

The maximum number of team cars in the convoy is 15 per race. For each country there are 5 car places per race. Every federation will present combined team cars to organizing federation (ejl@ejl,ee) by 17.06.21 16:00.

The drawing lots for team cars will be held at the end of the team managers meeting 18.06.21 10:00 using www.random.org/lists randomizer.

The order of team cars in the race will be determined as follows:

- 1.In between combined list of team cars presented to the organizing federation.
- 2. If the number of cars per race is less than 15 and team managers present a candidate at the team managers meeting for the free places a second order will be determined in between these teams.

The driver of the escort car must have a valid UCI licence.

Competition information is transmitted by Radio Tour transmitters on the frequency approved for EJL.

Official prize ceremony

The winner of the age category will be named Baltic champion and will be awarded with a prize from competition partners. The second and third place winners will be awarded with a prize from competition partners.

Official awards ceremony must be attended by all athletes who have won prizes in their age category. Athletes who do not appear for the award will lose their right to the prizes and may be fined in accordance with the UCI regulations.

Riders must present themselves in race clothing, wearing their team jersey and shall not wear a cap, headband, glasses or any other accessory until they leave the podium ceremony area. Due to the pandemic Covid-19, riders must wear a face mask into the podium ceremony dedicated space and also on the podium.

SANITARY PROTOCOL

General requirements

Face masks must be worn at all times at the event venue, except for riders during training, warming up and racing. Any person at the event venue who is seen to be without a mask for an extended period will have their accreditation removed.

Social distancing of minimum 2m is expected at all times. Keep in mind that face masks on their own cannot provide complete protection against infection, and there is a need to use them alongside maintaining physical distance.

Regular hand washing/sanitizing is expected. Hand sanitizer will be provided at multiple locations on the event area.

It is the responsibility of the club/team representative or athlete to perform health checks. Participation in competitions for persons with symptoms (both competitors and competition organizers) is prohibited.

The organizer of the competition has the right to remove a person with symptoms and a person or persons who have been in contact with them from the competition if they have at least one of the following symptoms:

COVID-19 symptoms
Fever > 38'C
Cough
Shortness of breath
Stuffy nose or sore throat
Unusula aches
Abnormal fatigue
Unusual headache
Diarrhea/vomiting

Every worker and volunteer involved with the race must be familiar with the COVID-19 manual and follows the instructions.
